Cookie Policy

The website www.bugli.se uses cookies. This Policy states what they are used for and how they can be deleted.

1. Definition

Cookies are small text files with information that are automatically saved by a website user's device. Cookies are typically used to improve the user experience for visitors to a website.

There are two different types of cookies: persistent cookies and session cookies. Persistent cookies store data for an extended period of time and are activated every time a user visits the website. Session cookies expire at the end of a browser session, and are deleted when the user exits the website/browser.

2. How cookies are used

We use cookies to improve the user experience. We use both persistent cookies and session cookies.

2.1 Persistent cookies

The following information is stored in the form of persistent cookies:

Name: bugli-cookie-accepted

Purpose: Saves information on your computer that you accept cookies. Saved for 30 days. This is essential and cannot be disabled.

2.2 Session cookies

The following information is saved in the form of session cookies: Name: ASP.NET_SessionId

Purpose: Does not save any personally identifiable information, and is only used to ensure that the website's code and functionality work properly. This is essential and cannot be disabled.

2.3 Third-party cookies

We do not use third-party cookies.

3. Consent

3.1 Obtain consent

We obtain consent as follows:

Cookie consent is obtained on the website via a cookie banner. The user agrees to cookies by clicking "Accept."

3.2 Consent validity

Consent to the use of cookies lasts for 30 days. At the end of this period, new consent must be obtained for the continued use of cookies.

3.3 Withdraw consent

A user who has given consent may withdraw their consent at any time by doing the following:

Consent can be withdrawn in the user's browser settings.

3.4 Right to have their personal data erased
